Guidelines For Students

- i. All the admissions will be provisional subject to approval of the Principal and the University. If a student conceals any fact and provides false information, he/she can be restricted at any point of time.
- ii. Stream and section of the students cannot be changed after admission.
- iii. If a student fails to attend his/her classes continuously for seven days from the date of commencement of the classes or from the date of admission, his/her admission, shall be cancelled.
- iv. If a student remains absent from the classes for 14 days or more in a month, his name will be struck off from the rolls and his/her parents will also be informed.
- v. The shortage of lectures will be notified atleast thrice during the session by the Principal.
- vi. There will be only two chances of re-admission by paying the prescribed re-admission fee.
- vii. It is mandatory for a student to keep his/her identity card with him/her in the campus and produce it on demand by a staff member. In case of loss of identity card, duplicate card can be issued on paying Rupees 200.
- viii. Students are expected to maintain discipline and demonstrate good behaviour.
- ix. It is the moral duty of the students to safeguard the property of the college.
- x. Holding of any meeting without the permission of the Principal is prohibited.
- xi. No information can be put up on the notice board without the prior permission of the Principal.
- xii. Students are advised to utilise their time during free period in the Library or Common Room.
- xiii. Students must read notice board daily on entering and before leaving the college. They themselves will be responsible for any ignorance in this regard.
- xiv. College classes will start according to the scheduled time table and the Principal has every right to modify it.
- xv. A student must be present in the classroom at the very start of the period. A student cannot claim his/her right for attendance once the attendance has been taken by the teacher.
- xvi. Students must park their vehicles in the parking area. Vehicles parked anywhere else inside or outside will be confiscated and student will be liable to be fined or violation parking rules.
- xvii. Helmet is compulsory for two wheelers for their safety.
- xviii. Students must keep the environment neat and clean by using dustbins.
- xix. Girl students are expected to conduct themselves with dignity, modesty and simplicity. The girl students should wear sober dresses. They should avoid the use of shorts and skirts.

Rules For Internal Assessment

1. Internal assessment in all Under-Graduate and Post-Graduate courses is 20% in each theory paper based on the following criteria :
 - i. Two handwritten assignments
(1st assignments after one month & 2nd assignments after two months) : 10%
 - ii. One class test (one period duration) : 5%
 - iii. Attendance : 5%Marks for attendance will be given as under :
 - i. 91% onwards : 5 marks
 - ii. 81% to 90% : 4 marks
 - iii. 75% to 80% : 3 marks
 - iv. 70% to 74% : 2 marks*
 - v. 65% to 69% : 1 mark*

* For students engaged in co-curricular activities for the colleges and authenticated medical grounds duly approved by the Principal.
2. Eligibility for appearing in final exam is 20% marks in class tests, two assignments and 75% attendance.

समय समय पर महाविद्यालय में विद्यार्थियों के शारीरिक, मानसिक, सामाजिक तथा सामुदायिक विकास के लिए भाषण प्रश्नोत्तरी, पत्र-वाचन, वाद-विवाद, संगीत आदि प्रतियोगिताओं और चलचित्र प्रदर्शन तथा पर्यटन के कार्यक्रमों का आयोजन किया जाता है।

इन कार्यक्रमों में विद्यार्थियों की सहभागिता बढ़ाने व उन्हें आयोजन का अनुभव देने के उद्देश्य से निम्नलिखित विभागीय समितियों का गठन किया जाता है।

शैक्षणिक पर्यटन (Educational Visits)

सत्र के मध्य अवकाश के दिनों में प्राचार्य की अनुमति से विद्यार्थियों की शैक्षिक उन्नति के लिए शैक्षणिक पर्यटनों का आयोजन किया जाता है।



ज्ञानांजलि (College Magazine)

विद्यार्थियों की सृजनात्मक अभिव्यक्ति को निखारने के लिए महाविद्यालय द्वारा ज्ञानांजलि नामक वार्षिक पत्रिका का प्रकाशन किया जाता है। इसमें हिन्दी, संस्कृत पंजाबी, अंग्रेजी, हरियाणवी भाषाओं में विद्यार्थियों के लेख/कहानियाँ/कविता/चुटकुले/कार्टून आदि प्रकाशित किए जाते हैं।



दीक्षांत एवं पारितोषिक विरण समारोह (Convocation & Prize Distribution Function)

महाविद्यालय के दीक्षान्त एवं पारितोषिक वितरण समारोह में विद्यार्थियों को उपाधि से विभूषित किया जाता है तथा प्रतिभाशाली विद्यार्थियों को पुरस्कार देकर सम्मानित किया जाता है।

राष्ट्रीय सैन्य दल (NCC)

महाविद्यालय में राष्ट्रीय सैन्य दल की दो कम्पनियाँ हैं। एन.सी.सी. 'बी'



और 'सी' सर्टिफिकेट की परीक्षा में बैठने के लिए प्रत्येक एन.सी.सी. कैंडेट को कुल परेडों में 75 प्रतिशत उपस्थिति और शिविरों का लगाना भी अनिवार्य है। 'बी' तथा 'सी' सर्टिफिकेट प्राप्त एन.सी.सी. कैंडेट्स को सेना तथा अन्य सरकारी नौकरियों में प्राथमिकता मिलती है तथा उनके लिए स्थान आरक्षित है। 'सी' सर्टिफिकेट प्राप्त करने वाले विद्यार्थियों को स्नातकोत्तर कक्षा में प्रवेश लेने पर 5 अंको का अधिभार मिलता है।

राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना (NSS)

राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना की 100-100 विद्यार्थियों की तीन इकाइयाँ हैं। निर्धारित आवेदन-पत्र भरने पर राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना में प्रवेश के लिए विद्यार्थियों का चयन होता है। मैरिट सर्टिफिकेट प्राप्त करने वाले विद्यार्थियों को स्नातकोत्तर कक्षा में प्रवेश लेने पर 5 अंको का अधिभार मिलता है।

विधि साक्षरता प्रकोष्ठ (Legal Literacy Cell)

इस प्रकोष्ठ द्वारा विद्यार्थियों को महिलाओं, बुजुर्गों, विकलांगों तथा समाज उपयोगी अन्य कानूनों के बारे में जानकारी प्रदान की जाती है तथा इन कानूनों के प्रति जागृति करने के उद्देश्य से विभिन्न गतिविधियों का आयोजन किया जाता है।

महिला प्रकोष्ठ (Women Cell)

राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति के अंतर्गत हमारे कॉलेज में एक महिला प्रकोष्ठ की स्थापना की गई है। इस प्रकोष्ठ के निम्नलिखित उद्देश्य हैं:-

1. महिलाओं के अधिकारों के प्रति जागरूकता उत्पन्न करना तथा उन्हें किसी भी तरह के भेदभाव के विरुद्ध आवाज उठाने के लिए शिक्षित एवं प्रेरित करना।
2. छात्राओं की समस्याओं के समाधान हेतु सलाह प्रदान करना तथा उन्हें इस विषय में जानकारी दिलवाना।



3. छात्राओं के व्यक्तित्व को विकसित करने के लिए विभिन्न प्रकार की प्रतियोगिताओं का आयोजन करना।

चरित्र प्रमाण-पत्र (Character Certificate)

प्राचार्य की संतुष्टि के आधार पर विद्यार्थी को महाविद्यालय छोड़ते समय अथवा आवश्यकता पड़ने पर या उससे पूर्व भी चारित्रिक प्रमाण-पत्र दिया जा सकता है। सौ रुपये शुल्क देने पर विद्यार्थी प्रमाण-पत्र की प्रति पुनः प्राप्त कर सकता है।

पुरस्कार, पदक व छात्रवृत्तियाँ (Prizes, Medals & Scholarships)

कॉलेज के केन्द्रीय सरकार, राज्य सरकार, विश्वविद्यालय, अनुसूचित जाति/जनजाति कल्याण, सैनिक छात्रवृत्ति तथा निर्धन कोष से दिए जाने वाली निम्नलिखित छात्रवृत्तियाँ उपलब्ध हैं -

1. विश्वविद्यालय परीक्षाओं में प्रतिभाशाली विद्यार्थियों को हरियाणा राज्य सरकार तथा विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा प्रदत्त छात्रवृत्ति।
2. विश्वविद्यालय तथा राज्य शिक्षा विभाग के नियमों के अंतर्गत अनुसूचित जाति, जनजाति व पिछड़ी जाति के विद्यार्थियों को प्रदान की जाती है।
3. उपरोक्त छात्रवृत्तियों के अतिरिक्त दानी महापुरुषों द्वारा भी छात्रवृत्तियाँ व पदक भी हैं, जो योग्य तथा निर्धन छात्रों को दिए जाते हैं।

विभिन्न छात्रवृत्तियाँ (Scholarships)

शिक्षा विभाग द्वारा प्रदत्त निम्नलिखित छात्रवृत्तियों के लिए विद्यार्थी अपना आवेदन पत्र दिनांक 15 सितंबर तक कार्यालय में अवश्य ही प्रस्तुत करें।



1. अनुसूचित जाति एवं अनुसूचित जनजातियों से संबंधित विद्यार्थियों के लिए उपरांत छात्रवृत्ति (Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes):

इस योजना के अंतर्गत वे विद्यार्थी जो राज्य सरकार द्वारा मान्यता प्राप्त अनुसूचित जाति व अनुसूचित जनजाति से संबंधित हैं और उनके माता-पिता की वार्षिक आय 2,50,000 रुपये से अधिक न हो, उन विद्यार्थियों को छात्रवृत्ति प्रदान की जाती है।

2. पिछड़ा वर्ग से संबंधित विद्यार्थियों के लिए मैट्रिक उपरांत छात्रवृत्ति (Backward Class):

इस योजना के अंतर्गत वे विद्यार्थी जो राज्य सरकार द्वारा मान्यता प्राप्त पिछड़ी जातियों से संबंधित हैं और उनके माता पिता की वार्षिक आय 1,00,000 रुपये से अधिक नहीं है, उन विद्यार्थियों को छात्रवृत्ति प्रदान की जाती है।

आवश्यक : अनुसूचित जाति, जनजाति एवं पिछड़ी जाति के विद्यार्थियों को सूचित किया जाता है कि वे छात्रवृत्ति प्राप्त करने हेतु कॉलेज में प्रवेश-पत्र के साथ ही छात्रवृत्ति फार्म भर कर कॉलेज में जमा करा दें ताकि उनकी छात्रवृत्ति पाने की पुष्टि समय पर हो सके तथा उन्हें बिना विलम्ब छात्रवृत्ति प्रदान की जा सके। ऐसे विद्यार्थियों को निम्न प्रमाण पत्र छात्रवृत्ति फार्म के साथ कॉलेज कार्यालय में जमा करना आवश्यक है –

क. अनुसूचित जाति/जनजाति/पिछड़े वर्ग का प्रमाण पत्र
ख. पिछली वार्षिक कक्षा का उत्तीर्ण प्रमाण-पत्र

ग. माता-पिता की वार्षिक आय का प्रमाण पत्र (सरकारी कर्मचारी वार्षिक आय का प्रमाण पत्र अपने कार्यालय से एवं गैर सरकारी व्यक्ति का आय प्रमाण पत्र 10/- रुपये के शपथ पत्र पर तहसीलदार द्वारा प्रमाणित होना आवश्यक है।

नोट :- छात्रवृत्ति प्राप्त करने के लिए विद्यार्थी को अपने आधार कार्ड की प्रतिलिपि देना अनिवार्य है। अनुसूचित जाति/जनजाति/पिछड़े वर्ग से संबंधित सभी विद्यार्थियों को अपना बैंक खाता यूनियन बैंक ऑफ इंडिया, आर.के.एस. डी. कॉलेज ब्रांच में खुलवाना आवश्यक है। बैंक का खाता नंबर छात्रवृत्ति फार्म पर लिखना अनिवार्य है, अन्यथा फार्म नहीं लिया जायेगा।

3. हरियाणा राज्य समाज कल्याण विभाग द्वारा विकलांग छात्रवृत्ति :

इस योजना के अंतर्गत वे विद्यार्थी जिनकी 40 प्रतिशत अथवा अधिक विकलांगता है एवं उसके माता पिता की वार्षिक आय 72,000 से अधिक नहीं है, वे विद्यार्थी विकलांग छात्रवृत्ति फार्म कॉलेज में प्रवेश करते समय कॉलेज कार्यालय में निम्न प्रमाण पत्र सहित अवश्य जमा करवा दें –

क. माता-पिता की वार्षिक आय प्रमाण-पत्र (मूलरूप में) 10 रु. के शपथ पत्र पर
ख. विकलांग प्रमाण-पत्र
ग. पिछली वार्षिक कक्षा का उत्तीर्ण प्रमाण-पत्र
घ. सभी प्रमाण पत्रों की फोटोस्टेट कॉपी प्रमाणित होनी चाहिए।

4. राष्ट्रीय/राज्य योग्यता/सिल्वर जुबली छात्रवृत्ति :

इस योजना के अंतर्गत जिन विद्यार्थियों ने 12वीं की वार्षिक परीक्षा हरियाणा शिक्षा बोर्ड, भिवानी से उत्तीर्ण की हो एवं कॉलेज में बी.ए./बी.कॉम./बी.एस.सी./बी.बी.ए./बी.सी.ए. प्रथम वर्ष में प्रवेश लिया हो, उस छात्र/छात्रा को योग्यता के आधार पर हरियाणा शिक्षा बोर्ड भिवानी/हरियाणा राज्य सरकार द्वारा छात्रवृत्ति प्रदान की जाती है। राष्ट्रीय/राज्य योजना छात्रवृत्ति केवल प्रथम डिग्री परीक्षा तक मिलेगी।
