Extension Lecture on "Intonation in English Speech"

Date: 13th October 2019

Two extension lectures on "Intonation in English Speech" were organized under the aegis of the Department of English at RKSD College. The main speaker on the occasion was Prof Avinash Pathak, Associate Professor at Government College, Narwana. On reaching the college Principal Dr Sanjay Goyal welcomed him. Dr Suruchi Sharma convened the event and introduced the speaker to the audience. Prof Avinash Pathak is a Gold Medalist in MA Linguistics and MA Philosophy. Along with being a master of his subject, he passed various courses in French, German, Punjabi and Urdu languages. He explained that the sounds related to English language are also similar to other languages. The understanding of students in learning the language depends on how and in what tone they pronounce the sounds in words. Remember that the subjects 'Intonation' and 'Phonetics' are being taught across all B.A. and M.A. (English) streams in approximately all the colleges of the state. So, describing it as an important and special achievement of the English Department, Dr Sanjay Goyal said that lecturing on such a subject shows a strong step in itself which we are taking towards our language. English language today is not difficult in any way but it should be just that we try to learn the science related to language and its related information through a good teacher. The head of the department Dr Rajbir Parashar thanked Prof Avinash Pathak on behalf of the entire department. Dr Geeta Goyal, Dr Vikas Bhardwaj, Dr Manjula Goyal, Prof Jaibir Dhariwal, Dr SP Verma, Prof Naresh Garg, Prof Anjali, Prof Richa, Prof Nidhi, Prof Archana Tiwari and Prof Pranjal Thareja were present on the occasion. Online Seminar/Workshop on Critical Appreciation of a Poem

Date: - 4th July 2020

A national-level Online Seminar on the topic "Critical Appreciation of a Poem" was organized by the English Literary Society of RKSD PG College, Kaithal. Prof. Dinesh Dadhichi, the former Chairperson of the Department of English, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, was the keynote speaker. While explaining the meaning of the critical study of poetry, Prof. Dadhichi said that it is necessary to evaluate and analyze a poem in order to understand it better. To write a critical analysis of a poem, it is important to first evaluate the poetic techniques used by the poet. It includes genre analysis. Each style has its own distinct characteristics. Sonnet has 14 lines divided into three quatrains and a couplet. Thus poetry can be a ballad, an ode, a lyric, song, etc. After doing all the analysis and evaluation, the reader should first describe the poem and then explain it comprehensively in his own words. Around 1,600 e-registrations were received for this Online Seminar, from every nook and cranny of India and some from foreign countries too. A large number of participants were from the Southern part of India from states like Tamilnadu, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh, and Telangana. Participants from J &K and Northeast of India also very zealously took part in the seminar. Registrations were also received from Saudi Arabia, UK, Oman, and Egypt.


The Seminar was held on the Zoom platform with simultaneous Live-streaming on YouTube. Around 2500 views were recorded on YouTube Live which later grew to more than 3000.

The Principal of the College, Dr S K Goyal, welcomed the guest speaker and other participants. He also apprised the participants about the College and its activities. 
Seven Days Orientation Programme


सात दिवसीय यूजीसी नेट अंग्रेजी विषय पर अभिविन्यास कार्यक्रम सम्पन्न

Report and Learning Outcomes

Short-Term Certificate Course in 'Communication Skills and Soft Skills'

Department of English in collaboration with Career Guidance, Advancement and Counselling Cell of the College organised Add-on course namely 'Short-term Certificate Course in Communication Skills and Soft Skills' w.e.f. 9th December, 2021 to 19th February,2022.The course was open for all the students of BA/B.Sc/B.Com/ BCA/BBA/MA/M.Sc/M.Com. of Morning and Evening sessions of the college. Applications were invited through google form provided by notice circulated on 23.11.2021. It was planned that the duration of the course would be 40 hours with Rs. 900/- as total fee, collected by Mr. Rakesh Kumar, fee clerkfor the morning session and Ms Neha Fee clerk, evening session. 26 students got enrolled.

The syllabus was designed in a well-planned manner after a number of meetings, deliberations and discussions with the HoD of English, senior faculty of the Department, Convener and members of Career Guidance Cell. The syllabus was divided among seven faculty members: Dr Rajbir Parashar, Dr Geeta Goyal and Dr Suruchi Sharma, Dr Naresh Garg, Ms. Richa Langyan from the Department; Ms Rachna Sardana, Commerce Department and Dr Naresh Kumar, Librarian. To make the course more convenient for students, classes were held in blended mode.

Four modules were prepared which covered almost all the aspects of communication and soft skills such as communication and it's types, effective communication and effective selfexpression, speech, elocution, extempore, debate,nuances of group discussion,dialogue in formal and informal situations, techniques of reading,grammatical concepts,vocabulary building, business writing skills, self-presentation for employment, listening to text, CDs, interpretation of text, leadership, teamwork, interpersonal skills and success in interviews etc.

Students were evaluated throughwritten worksheets, assignments and presentations. Attendanceand class performancewas also considered. Interview and viva was held teacherwise at the end of the programme. Thereafter, grades were awarded and certificates were issued. Total duration of the course was 38hrs and teachers were paid Rs. 500/- per lecture. Three students got 'O' grade with 85% marks, 7 'A+ (70-80%) and 13 got 'A' grade with 69% marks. Dr Geeta Goyal and Dr Suruchi Sharma acted as conveners whereas Ms. Richa Langyan, Ms. Rachna Sardana were organising secretaries of the programme.

- 1. Qualitative enhancement of major skills in formal and informal communication.
- 2. Self-confident Personality orientation for career and life goals.
