
Academic Karma Series: Two days National Webinar held on 31st May-1st June, 2021 (Under Veda Vyaas Restructuring Sanskrit Scheme)

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
Academic Karma Series: National Webinar held on 25 September, 2021


Academic Karma Series: National Webinar held on 04 December, 2021

Topic: "Critique of Idea & Concept of Justice in Indian & Western Tradition" (भारतीय एवम् पाश्चात्य परम्परा में न्याय के विचार एवम् अवधारणा की मीमांसा)

Department of Sanskrit and Political Science of RKSD College, Kaithal, Sanatan Dharma Human Development, Research & Training Center (SDHDR&T), S D College Ambala Cantt, GMN College, SD Adarsh Sanskrit College, Ambala and MPN College, Mullana jointly organized a National Webinar on the topic- "Critique of Idea & Concept of Justice in Indian & Western Tradition" (भारतीय एवम् पाश्चात्य परम्परा में न्याय के विचार एवम् अवधारणा की मीमांसा) on 4 December 2021, in which 39 scholars, teachers & students participated. Dr. Chiman Lal, HOD, Pol. Sc. welcomed the resource person Dr. Ashutosh Dayal Mathur (Ph. No- 9971330167), Head, Department of Sanskrit, St. Stephen College, Delhi University, Delhi who talked about the various aspects of western tradition of justice along with the idea of Nyaaya as Dharma in Sanskrit Dharma-Shastra tradition. He referred to different sources of dharma-shastras regarding the various aspects of justice including issues of social justice. Department of Sanskrit initiated the discussion by raising various issues by PPT presentation like What justice is? What constitutes justice? What is the difference among Greek, Roman, Biblical, Islamic, Indian constitutional ideas & concepts of justice along with Sanskrit Shastrik concept of justice? NEETI & NYAAYA both stand for justice in classical Sanskrit, but both have been used in many different senses in different philosophical and legal discussions in ancient India. Among the principal uses of the term NITI are organizational propriety and behavioural correctness whereas the term Nyaaya stands for a more comprehensive concept of realized justice. Moreover, Dharma is a more appropriate concept rather than justice or Nyaaya. Department of Sanskrit shared four short stories to easily understand the concept of Justice from Greek, Western, Jew & Sanskrit tradition. Dr. Vinay Singhal, proposed the vote of thanks to all the participants and resource person for their valuable contributions.

Topic: "Critique of Sanskrit Shaastraiya Model of Indian Human Rights" (संस्कृत- शास्त्रीय भारतीय मानवाधिकार के प्रारूप की मीमांसा)

Departments of Sanskrit of RKSD College, Kaithal, GMN College, Ambala, MPN College, Mullana, SDA Sanskrit College, Ambala and Sanatan Dharma Human Development, Research & Training Center (SDHDR&T), S D College, jointly organized a National Webinar cum Open House Discussion on the topic "Critique of Sanskrit Shastraiya Model of Indian Human Rights" (संस्कृत- शास्त्रीय भारतीय मानवाधिकार के प्रारूप की मीमांसा) on 10 December 2021 in which 47 teachers, scholars & students participate and discussed about the human rights which emerged out of two bloody world wars which were forced upon the humanity by the west, as face saver. How with competitive market economy can UNO develop culture of human rights and moreover why Indian social scientists are still unable to develop their own idea and practices of human rights? Multiple issues were raised and discussed and at the outset, Department of Sanskrit proposed the model of human rights based on Sanskrit shastras for critical evaluation of scholars by a PPT presentation? Dr. Avinash K Shrivastava (Ph. No- 9334134122), Head Department of Buddhist Studies, Nalanda University, Bihar was the resource person. Dr. Neeraj, Dr. Vishal Bhardwaj, Dr. Rekha Aggarwal, Dr. Rajendra, Dr. Chanchal Sharma, Dr Yoga Shree Nath, Dr. Sushma Mehta, Dr Anand Gurhye, Dr Jaiprakash, Dr. Jyoti Sharma, Dr Roopika Bhanot, Dr Loveleen, Dr Meenakshi and others shared their Indian perspective of human rights & practices. Dr. C. K. Jha welcomed the speakers & participants and briefed about the idea of human rights. In the concluding session, Dr. Vinay Singhal proposed the vote of thanks.

The discussion concluded as follows- The history of the West makes it abundantly evident that all revolutions have only resulted in the transfer of power from the royal family to the capitalist class. Neither justice nor equality was the goal of these revolutions. Therefore, no matter how much reasoning and publicity is put into human rights, its fundamental tenets will still be distorted. No matter how strongly capitalism or socialism advocates about human rights, if their respective materialism rejects the power of man, then the success of human rights will be in doubt. As a result, as Indians, we should endeavour to address all human rights issues using our cultural ability and intelligence instead of the leadership of modernism and their subject matter experts. What kind of human rights policy is wanted, how to develop equality and a healthy society based on justice in the context of human rights?

Departments of Sanskrit & SDHDR&T Centre, S. D. College, GMN College, Arya Girls College, Ambala Cantt RKSD College, Kaithal and MPN College, Mullana jointly organized an online national webinar cum open house discussion on the topic- "Sanskrit Shaastriya Critique of Economy, Economics & Economist" (२१वीं शताब्दी में अर्थव्यवस्था, अर्थशास्त्र एवम अर्थशास्त्री की संस्कृत शास्त्रीय मीमांसा) on 21 January 2022, which was attended by 76 participants from different states. Prof. Dr. Sudhir Kumar (Ph. No- 8054368260), Department of English, Punjab University, Chandigarh was the resource person. Department of Sanskrit raised three main issues (Can Modern Economic View satisfy a person towards future? Can Modern Economic View encourage rich people to share their money with needy persons? Can Modern Economic View provide justice to poor people) through PPT presentation & talked about the concept of "Sensible Economics" based on Sanskrit Shaastras as GDP based economic model designed and developed for 7.5 billion people of one living earth has been able to generate facilities & conveniences for people in unequal & unjust manner because of which wellbeing is not happening so it's high time to rethink about our traditional wisdom regarding economics of wellbeing. The patch works like sustainable economics, green economics, and environmental economics are no sureties or securities for a safe, healthy human future on this one living planet called earth. It is because of these reasons we need to look for an alternative economic thinking in terms of sensible economics and evaluate the Karma & Dharma of economists based on Sanskrit Shaastras. The result of intellect-based economics is like- अन्धेनेव नीयमानः यथान्धः।

So, it's high time that we explore intelligence-based economics rather than intellectual economics. Prof. Dr. Sudhir Kumar, Department of English, Punjab University, Chandigarh & Coordinator of National Winter School of "ArthaaYaama" at IIAS, Shimla gave a brilliant account of ArthaaYaama as how to decolonize the minds of the upcoming generation of young teachers and researchers and remind them of the holistic dharmacentric nature of all Indic knowledge systems. It aimed at reading the economic aspect of life not only economistically but through the integral vision of Sanatan Dharmi Indic knowledge system so well envisioned as "Arthaayaama" (a concept used by Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya). Topic: "Physics of Panch MahaaBhoot" (पंचमहाभूतों की भौतिकी/भौतिकशास्त्र)

Departments of Sanskrit, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology of S.D. College, GMN College, Arya Girls College, Ambala Cantt, BAR Janta College, Kaul, MPN College, Mullana & RKSD College, Kaithal jointly organized a national webinar on the occasion of 'Shashti Poorthi & Sewa Nivriti' of "Dr. Sunil Sharma, Head & Associate Professor, PG Department of Physics" on the following topic- "Physics of Panch MahaaBhoot", (पंचमहाभूतों की भौतिकी/भौतिकशास्त्र) in which 47 participants took part from various states & institutions. This webinar was an attempt to open up a dialogue between Sanskrit shastriya & Physics understanding about the nature of matter, energy, time, space etc. Vedantic & Quantum theories reveal a basic oneness of the universe. They show that we cannot decompose the world into independently existing smallest units. As we penetrate into matter, nature does not show us any isolated "building blocks," but rather appears as a complicated web of relations between the various parts of the whole. These relations always include the observer in an essential way. The human observer constitutes the final link in the chain of observational processes, and the properties of any atomic object can be understood only in terms of the object's interaction with the observer. It is in this context we need to know about Physicists' understanding & response about the five Mahaa-Bhoot (basic elements)- Earth, Air, water, Fire & Aakash as we all are just 72% water, 12% earth, 6% air, 4% fire & the rest is Akasha. We have to find out the relationship between- that which has been given to us like nature including earth, air, water etc. and the symbols (Prateeka) we use to understand them. As Fritjof Capra rightly says in his book "Tao of Physics"- "The mystic and the physicist arrive at the same conclusion; one starting from the inner realm, the other from the outer world. The harmony between their views confirms the ancient Indian wisdom that Brahman, the ultimate reality without, is identical to Aatman, the reality within."

Prof (Dr.) Dheeraj Kumar Chaturvedi (Ph. No- 9896014243), Former Head, Department of Physics, Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra was the Resource person. He propounded the Indian perspective of science along with its history and then brilliantly propounded the various aspects of matter and Panch Mahabhootas and their atomic structures from Shastric tradition and western science. He talked about three laws of motion and their origin in Vaisheshik philosophy too. Department of Sanskrit introduced Dr. Sunil Sharma and duly acknowledged his contributions to the academic circle. All over Europe there are multiple ancient minority religious sects, who were persecuted by Church and other forces over a long period time western history. These religious minorities have roots in Indian tradition like- Deities, worship patterns, rituals, tradition etc. It is high time we make ourselves aware about their religion, culture & tradition etc and enhance our perception, understanding about the whole issue of suppressed religious minorities by Church & states in Europe. Major Surendra Narayan Mathur (Ph.No-7742635223), SM (Ex) & Associate Professor, Military Engineering College, Pune & presently Vishwa Vibhag Pramukh, Vanvaasi Kalyan Ashram was the resource person who had widely travelled all over Europe in last 20 years and interacted with these religious heads. He talked about his authentic first-hand knowledge with facts on the cultural, religious, ritualistic, linguistic similarities between multiple pre-Christian religions of Europe & ancient India. He opened up a new vista for teachers, students & research scholars of history, anthropology, sociology, archaeology, Sanskrit & others to study & research. As per their Sanskrit view point whole stress is emerging because of intellectual, emotional and karmic conflicts along with misuse of language by the so-called civilized men of 21st century. So, this webinar is an attempt to develop an alternative concept and practices to develop stress management based on Indian Knowledge Tradition. He talked about various issues like religious, political, administrative etc and gave factual accounts related to Kashmiri Hindu Genocide eruditely. Department of Sanskrit initiated the discussion by the raising issues the following manner- Genocide of Kashmiri Hindus including Sikhs forces us to ask- how Hindus are being treated & will be treated in future under secular constitutional India. Also, we need to assess the harm caused by malicious narratives designed and developed by agenda-based media and not only this, but also how politicians, Hindu hating leftists and bigots were treated in past and will treat Hindus in future. Kashmir is the burning example of this situation. There are horrifying stories which have been brushed under the secular carpet. We and upcoming future generations need to know these stories to understand where they will stand in the near future. Hindus can't behave like Jews and reclaim their Kashmir homeland under a secular constitution. So at least we all need to learn and keep them alive in our memories, the stories of atrocities committed on Hindus if we don't want more partition of constitutional India in near future. We need to keep alive the actual horrifying accounts of murder, rape, loot of kafirs of valley in a democratic India so that we all think about a way forward. In the open house discussion, following issues were raised by the participants- If India is a free nation and flourishes in democracy and human rights then what led to the violation of the human rights of a Hindu minority in a Muslim majority state? Have the fruits of democracy not reached the grass root level? Is J&K a Muslim sphere of influence where the writ of the Indian state is not implemented? Or is there some tacit understanding to accommodate the Muslim sub nationalism at the cost of the territorial integrity and sovereignty of the nation that swears in the public life by the principles of secularism? Why the Muslims in the rest of India have not spoken openly against the jihadi society of Kashmir that holds the nation to ransom? Muslims in India enjoy equal rights with their other compatriots all over the nation despite calling themselves as minority but why are the same rights of minority rights not applicable to the Hindus of Kashmir and other parts of the state including the Dogra Hindus of Jammu? Prof. Avinash Kumar Shrivastava, Dr. Vinay Singhal, Dr. Chanchal Sharma, Dr. Anubha Jain, Dr. Roopika Sharma, Sh. Sunil Raina & many others shared their views.
