• Department of Physics conducted a quiz on 'Nuclear Physics' on 19 October2019. It was conducted for students of B.Sc.-III.


Outcome: The activity improved the subject knowledge and confidence of the students.

Outcome: To improve the presentation skills of the students.


1. Coordinated 'Poster Making & Depicting Competition' was organized for all the sections of B.A.II on 1 October 2019.

DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS



DEPARTMENT OF PUNJABI


