Outcome: To make students familiarise and understand the social fabric, importance of relationships in society, and improve their writing skill.








Outcome: To enhance the creative skills and improve expression of students.



Outcome: To assess the level of understanding of the students.






Outcome: To give students exposure of experts and students from different languages and states.

Outcome: To aware the students about the role of great freedom fighters in India's Freedom Struggle movement.




