

**SERVICES:**

**IPD (Indoor Patient Department):** With regard to indoor admissions, the patient entitled for these services shall be given:

- 15% (Fifteen Percent) discount on the tariff prevailing at the time of billing on total bill Except Implants, Medicines and Consumables & out sourced Investigations (Such as biopsies, thyroid tests etc). However these discounts will not be valid for both the OPD & IPD facilities for:
  1. The employees covered under any Medclaim policy or Third party Administrator.
  2. Any outsourced Investigations and Departments (Skin, Dental Physiotherapy)
- 10% Relaxation on the pharmacy Bill's.

**OPD facilities:** With regard to the OPD facilities, Patients will be given:

- 50% Relaxation on OPD Consultation Charges and 20% off on the Lab and Radiology investigations.
- Pharmacy: 10% Relaxation on the Pharmacy billing.
- **Health Camp & Awareness talk:** Shah Hospital, Kaithal offer frequent complementary Health talk and camp in your premises. The area of concern/ specialty can be decided by mutual confirmation from both the parties.
- **On Call Charges:-** Complementary Ambulance service (Only for Kaithal) in case of hospitalization will be provided in case the patient gets admitted in our Shah Hospital, Kaithal.

#### **TERMS & CONDITIONS:**

1. Employees/dependents should carry their company ID card to avail the corporate discount.
2. This offer cannot be clubbed with any other scheme/offer/promotional activity.
3. Rates would be subject to revision (For OPD, IPD, & Health Checkups).

#### **PAYMENT TERMS:**

- Hospital will do the billing as per the prevailing tariff at the time of billing.
- The applicability of the association (MOU/Contract) shall be for a period of 2 (Two) years from the date of entering into an association and shall stand extended for a further period of 2 (Two) years on each occasion if no party gives notice on non-renewal, 15 days prior to the expiry of the agreement. The agreement can be terminated by either party with a 30 days notice period in case if the mutual objectives are not being met.
- Payment for OPD services will be collected directly from the patient at the time of availing the services.
- All payments are to be made in respect of the final bill generated by hospital on the basis of the treatment of the patient in the hospital (for indoor patients & ON Site OPD). Company will pay all the responsible for any payments. All the payments shall be in the 30 days of submission of bills.

**OBLIGATIONS OF THE SECOND PARTY (R.K.S.D (P.G)College:**

- In case of any misbehave and disciplinary issue from the patient or attendant, the Second Party shall be liable for the same;
- Any changes in the constitution of the Second Party shall be informed to Shah Hospital;
- The Second Party shall be liable and responsible to make all statutory payments to its employee and personnel and fulfill all other statutory obligation and liabilities.

**DISPUTE RESOLUTION AND JURISDICTION:**

- In Case of any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with or relating to this Agreement, termination or validity hereof, the Parties shall attempt to first resolve such dispute or claim through discussions between senior executives of the Parties;
- If any dispute, difference or claim arises between the Parties in connection with this Agreement or the validity, interpretation, implementation or alleged breach of this Agreement or anything done, omitted to be done pursuant to this Agreement, the Parties shall first endeavor to resolve the same through conciliation and negotiation. However, if the dispute is not resolved through conciliation and negotiation then the Parties may refer the dispute for resolution to a sole arbitrator, to be appointed by mutual consent of the Parties. Such Arbitration shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, or any statutory modification of re-enactment for the time being in force. The Arbitration shall be in English Language. The venue of Arbitration shall be Kaithal. The cost of such Arbitration shall be borne by the Parties.
- Subject to provisions of Clause ii above, the courts in Kaithal shall have exclusive jurisdiction on any matter arising out of this Agreement.



## Agreement for Disposal E-Waste

This Agreement for collection, storage, transportation, dismantling and recycling of E-Waste (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") is made at Kaithal on this day of 1<sup>st</sup> July'2020. This agreement is only for 3 Years 1<sup>st</sup> July '2020 to 30<sup>th</sup> June '2023.

Between

R.K.S.D (P.G) College, Kaithal commonly known as RKSD College, established in 1954 and situated in Kaithal (hereinafter referred as "Customer" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include their successors, legal representatives and permitted assigns) of the one Part.;

And

Next Generation Computers, a Partnership Concern, and having its registered office at SCO 419-20, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Sector 35C, Chandigarh, India (hereinafter referred to as 'NextGEN' which expression shall unless repugnant to the context and meaning thereof mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) of the other Part.

Customer and NextGEN shall be individually and collectively referred as "Party" and "Parties" respectively.

### WHEREAS –

1. The customer namely R.K.S.D (P.G) College of Institutes commonly known as RKSD College, is a graduate and post graduate college, established in 1954 and situated at Kaithal. The customer generates e-waste while carrying out academic activities while using Computers, Printers and other Electronic parts (hereinafter referred to as "e-waste" and more particularly specified in Annexure – thereto) and intends to dispose of the said e- waste generated as per guidelines of the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Ministry of Environment & Forests.
2. NextGEN has represented that it is a certified Collection Centre of RESPL, an e-waste disposal agency by the Uttarakhand Environment Protection & Pollution Control Board bearing Registration Number UEPPCB/HO/E-Waste Recycler/03/2014/1547, issued on 03.03.2014 and is operating a facility for collection, storage, transportation, dismantling and recycling of E-Waste and have sufficient infrastructure, manpower, skills and facilities to dispose of the said e-waste without harming the environment in the manner prescribed by the concerned authorities.

3. Upon the representations of NextGEN, the Customer has agreed to provide and NextGEN has agreed to ensure compliance to E-Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2016 or any modification or enactment thereof ("Rules"), take charge of the said e-waste, collect, remove and dispose of the same from all the locations as specified by Customer from time to time in the manner prescribed by the concerned authorities on the following terms and conditions agreed to between the parties.

NOW IT IS AGREED BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

I) NextGEN's responsibilities:

1. The Customer hereby appoints NextGEN as the e-waste recyclers for its e-waste.
2. NextGEN in association with RESPL shall ensure compliance to all applicable provisions of the Rules including but not limited to registration, maintenance of records, filing of returns etc.
3. The Customer agrees to provide e-waste and the NextGEN agrees to take charge of the e-waste.
4. The Customer shall send written intimation to NextGEN whenever specified quantity of e-waste is accumulated/generated. The said e-waste shall be collected from the specified location within 7 days of intimation by the Customer. It will be the responsibility of the NextGEN to collect the same and have the same transported from the location as may be specified by the Customer from time to time to recycler's facility at its own costs & expenses in accordance with the guidelines and procedures prescribed by applicable authorities/laws.
5. NextGEN will get Form signed from the authorised representative of the Customer as an acknowledgement of e-waste handed over.
6. The representative of NextGEN shall have the right to inspect the said e-waste before the said e-waste is collected from the specified location.
7. NextGEN shall lift the specified material at the rates mutually agreed between the parties. NextGEN also agrees to pay the value of the e-waste before lifting the material from the premises of Customer.
8. It would be the responsibility of NextGEN for safe & secured transition of the e-waste collected from the specified location to the destination.

9. The responsibility of safe & secured storage, segregation, recycling, extraction, destruction, disposal of the e-waste will be that of NextGEN in association RESPL as per the guidelines of the Central and relevant State Pollution Control Board and other authorities and RESPL shall issue a destruction certificate and a detailed report to the Customer within 45 days from the date of collection of the e-waste from the Customer.
10. NextGEN warrants that it shall not compromise with the data stored on e-waste handed over by the Customer or any other data devices received along with the e-waste. NextGEN also warrants that all data shall be destroyed and NextGEN shall issue a certificate certifying the destruction of any data present in the e-waste handed over to them.

## II) Code of Conduct

Parties agree to conduct all their dealings with the other Party, its management, employees and other **सत्यम् शिवम् सुन्दरम्** ethical manner. This includes billing for only the Services provided and seeking to be compensated fairly as per the business arrangements and not in any other unfair manner.

NextGEN undertakes to confirm its compliance to ethical dealings on an annual basis, by signing a certificate to the effect that it has complied with the Company's code of conduct in all dealings with the Customer.

## III) Confidentiality

NextGEN acknowledges and agrees that all it shall throughout the term of this Agreement and even thereafter ensure any Confidential Information of Company is not used or permitted to be used in any manner incompatible or inconsistent with that authorized by Customer. It shall use such Confidential Information only for the purpose for which it was disclosed by Customer and shall not use or exploit such Confidential Information for its own benefit or the benefit of another; Protect the Confidential Information against disclosure to third parties in the same manner and with the same degree of care, but not less than a reasonable degree of care, with which it protects its confidential information of similar importance; and limit disclosure of Confidential Information received under this Agreement to persons within its organization who have a need to know such Confidential Information in the

course of the performance of their duties for the purpose of this Agreement and who are bound to protect the confidentiality of such Confidential Information under a written agreement having terms substantially similar to the terms hereof.

At the expiration or termination of this Agreement, for any reasons as provided for in the Agreement, all such documented confidential information (and all copies thereof whether in the documented form or disc or in any other media) owned by a Party ("Requesting Party" hereinafter) will be returned immediately to the Requesting Party or will be destroyed, with written certification thereof being given to the Requesting Party, provided that each Party may retain, in the sole custody of its Legal Counsel's Office, certain categories of confidential information identified to the Requesting Party and which are reasonably necessary to substantiate compliance with this Agreement or otherwise required for financial or operational auditing purposes. Any residual retention will remain subject to the confidentiality obligations under this Agreement. When such retained information is no longer reasonably required, it shall be returned to the Requesting Party or will be destroyed, with written certification thereof to the Requesting Party.

The contents of this Agreement shall be deemed to be confidential. This clause shall survive for a period of 5 years from the date of termination and earlier determination of this Agreement.

#### IV) Term and Termination:

1. The duration of the Agreement shall be Three years from the date hereof, unless it is terminated earlier as hereinafter provided. On the expiration of the said period, the agreement shall stand terminated and may be renewed by the parties with mutual consent at any time during the pendency of the agreement or even after.
2. If any party hereto commits breach of any terms of this agreement the other party will be entitled to give notice to the other party to rectify the breach within 30 days of the receipt of notice and if breach is not rectified, then the party giving notice shall be entitled to terminate this Agreement.
3. Either Party may voluntarily terminate this agreement by giving 30 days' notice to the other party. Also, the agreement may be terminated if:
  - a) The either party goes into liquidation, voluntary or compulsory or

- b) If either party feels that the continuance of the agreement is prejudicial to the business of the party for any reason, in such case this agreement can be terminated by either party by giving one month's notice in writing to the other party.
- c) If the agreement becomes impossible of performance by reason of College of customer being closed for more than 3 months due to strike of the employees of the customer or by reason of the customer closing its business in respect of the said goods or by reason of any force majeure.

## V) General Clauses

### 1. Assignment

NextGEN shall not assign or purport to assign or otherwise deal with any of its rights and obligations hereunder, except with the express prior written consent of the Customer.

### 2. Notice

Except as specifically provided elsewhere in this Agreement, all notices required or permitted to be given by one Party to the other under this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be sufficient if made (i) by personal delivery, (including delivery by any commercial delivery service with acknowledgment received); or (ii) by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested; or (iii) by facsimile transmission ("Fax") to the Parties at the respective addresses mentioned in this Agreement or to such other person or address as the Party to receive the notice has designated by notice to RESPL. The date upon which such notice is so actually delivered; or if the notice is given by registered or certified mail, the date upon which it is deposited in the mail; or if sent by Fax, the date on which the Fax was sent, provided an original is received by the addressee by any commercial delivery service within two (2) business days of the Fax, shall be deemed to be the date of such notice, irrespective of the date appearing therein.

### 3. Waiver

Failure to enforce compliance with any term or condition of this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver of such term or condition of this Agreement or the right to subsequently enforce such term or condition in the future. No waiver, by either Party, of any provision of this Agreement shall, in any event, become effective unless the

#### 4. Severability

If any provision of this Agreement shall be found by any Government or administrative body of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such provision shall not affect the other provisions of this Agreement and all provisions not affected by such invalidity or unenforceability shall remain in full force and effect. The Parties hereby agree to attempt to substitute for any invalid or unenforceable provision with a valid or enforceable provision, which achieves to the greatest extent possible the economic, legal and commercial objectives of the invalid or unenforceable provision.

#### 5. Survival

Any and all obligations under this Agreement which, by their very nature should reasonably survive the termination or expiration of this Agreement, will so survive, including, but not limited to, those arising from the NextGEN' warranty, confidentiality, Intellectual Property and non-solicitation provisions of this Agreement.

#### 6. Force Majeure

No failure or omission by either Party to carry out or observe or perform any of the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall give rise to any claim against such Party or be deemed a breach of this Agreement if such failure or omission arises from an act of God, an act or omission of Government, war or military operations, national or local emergency, acts or omissions of Government, fire, lightning, explosion, flood, subsidence, inclement weather, acts or omissions of persons or bodies for whom the Party is not responsible or any other cause whether similar or dissimilar outside such Party's control.

#### 7. Counterparts, Captions & References to Statutes or Statutory Provision

This Agreement may be executed simultaneously in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. The captions and headings are for convenience of reference

NextGEN agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Customer, its Affiliates and its Agents and their officers, directors, employees and agents from and against any and all losses, liabilities, claims pertaining to injury to any persons/damage to any property, obligations, damages, costs, expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys' fees) which directly or indirectly result from, arise in connection with or are related in any way to the provision of any services by NextGEN/its Affiliates or their associates or employees.

## 11. Relationship

The relationship of Parties established by this Agreement is that of independent contractors, and nothing in this Agreement shall be construed: (1) to give either party the power to direct or control the daily activities of the other party; (2) to constitute


## 12. Compliance with Laws

**Objective of MOU:**

The primary objective of this MOU between Trainer and R.K.S.D. (PG) College, Kaithal, the trainee institute is to collaborate to enhance the overall quality of the trainee institutes by Training the students to enable them to get suitable work experience in the field.





1. **Facilitate Assessment & Certification of students undergoing training as per this MOU:** The COLLEGE will permit the BFSI SSC to conduct assessments and certify the trainees of batches trained as per the respective QP / NOS under the BFSI SSC, through Assessment Agencies empaneled by the BFSI SSC.
2. **Nodal Officers/ Coordinators:** The COLLEGE will designate and recommend a Nodal Officer/ Coordinators at Headquarters Level who will be responsible for overseeing/coordinating the program from COLLEGE
3. **Payment Schedule to Sector Skill Councils:** The COLLEGE shall make 100% advance payment of assessment Fee to BFSI SSC.
  - a. Assessment Fee shall be paid on the basis of registered/scheduled number of candidates (this covers those passed, failed and also covers absentees on the day of the assessment as well) subject to a minimum batch-size, which is 15 candidates per batch. The Fee for an assessment and the subsequent

certification will be as per the norms of NSDC & BFSI SSC and currently is at INR. 800/-(Services Sector) plus GST.

- b. If a batch assessment is not conducted on the due date then the assessment will be carried out for the whole batch at a mutually convenient date. However, a fee of Rs.10000/- per batch will be levied for every change request for the date of assessment. This will be payable in advance.

4. **MIS:** Generate MIS. The COLLEGE will appoint a dedicated executive for the same who will be responsible to coordinate the technical operations with the BFSI SSC.

#### **C. Role & Responsibility of the BFSI SSC**

1. **Single Point of Contact (SPoC):** The BFSI SSC will designate and recommend a SPoC who will be responsible for the overall assessment related activities from the BFSI SSC.
2. **Student Assessment and Certification:** The BFSI SSC will organize the timely assessment and certification of training through 'Assessment Agencies', certified and approved by the BFSI SSC. The BFSI SSC will issue a certificate to the successful candidate along with the COLLEGE via NSDC's SDMS (Skill Development Management System).

#### **D. The following process followed for Assessments and Certification will be the responsibility of the COLLEGE:**

1. COLLEGE uploads its batch information on NSDC's SDMS Portal or any other medium as both parties think fit.
2. The COLLEGE allocates the QP trained batches to the BFSI SSC to get the assessments conducted through the BFSI SSC Assessment Provider. Until the integration between the COLLEGE Portal and SDMS is complete, all this information would be communicated via E-Mail
3. The COLLEGE will transfer the requisite assessment fees via cheque/DD/RTGS to the BFSI SSC, as mentioned in Clause B, Sub clause (3) of this Agreement.

#### **E. The following process for Assessments and Certification will be the responsibility of the BFSI SSC:**

1. The BFSI SSC will get updates of new batch/already registered on SDMS, to be assessed. The BFSI SSC will be responsible for allocating an Assessment Agency which is empanelled with it for Assessment. Certification, will be carried out as per NSDC's norms. The BFSI SSC via its Assessment Provider will be responsible for the fair and proper conduct of the QP assessment. Any issue/s that arise regarding this will be amicably discussed between the BFSI SSC and the COLLEGE and resolved thereof.
2. BFSI SSC to ensure that only registered batches on SDMS or on the COLLEGE portal will be assessed. Communication /request for the assessment date must be made at least 3 weeks before the batch training end date, at the Training Centre of the COLLEGE. However in case of malpractice or non-compliance of attendance by trainees at the test centre for an assessment, the full assessment amount has to be paid and any re-assessment will attract a new fee.
3. The BFSI SSC shall provide a statement of payments received along with requisite invoice for the same.
4. The BFSI SSC designated Assessment Provider's proctor/invigator /assessor will check the credentials of the candidates as per the established BFSI SSC norms and conditions; details of infrastructure and logistics required are included as Annexure-II to this Agreement. The following document will be checked to authenticate candidate identity at the Test Centre; ID proof- as mentioned in Annexure -II will also be provided by Second Party's
5. The COLLEGE will make all arrangements at the centre such as raw material, lab facilities, and infrastructure setup for the proctor to conduct the online assessment. Information about such arrangements will be provided to college by The BFSI SSC Assessment Provider; details of infrastructure and logistics required are included as Annexure -II to this Agreement.
6. Assessment for the complete batch will be done as per the norms of the First Party in terms of number of minimum and maximum number of candidates. Candidates will be assessed on the assessment criteria and Question Banks set by the BFSI SSC as per the respective QP concerned.

8. Secured certificates will be generated for successful candidates and the BFSI SSC will aim to forward the same in 30 days of declaration of the result and share with the COLLEGE.
