The college campus is under the surveillance of 70 CCTV cameras at strategic positions and equipped with public sound system. A security agency has been engaged to provide round the clock security to the premises. A water purifier plant, in addition to 9 water coolers, has been installed to provide hygienic drinking water in the campus. A dispensary in coordination with RKSD (PG) College of Pharmacy is working in the college. The services of Medical Officers are arranged as and when required.


