Policy on Water Conservation

As the college campus is situated in the agriculture dominated area, 'water conservation' is being given utmost priority as the ground water level in adjoining area is continuously depleting. Keeping this in mind College has framed the following water conservation policy and initiatives:

- Installation of rainwater borewells for improving depth to water levels.
- Sustainable storm water management practices where a system shall be developed to recharge the ground water with excess water accumulated on the main road in front of the college during the rainy season.
- Use of recycled water to minimize the need for piped water from Municipal supply for gardening.
- Watering to the gardening to be done in the morning or in the evening to reduce evaporation losses.
- Using suitable equipment, technology and systems to reduce the amount of water used
- Reduce the wastage of water by fitting proper valves and arrest the leakages.
- To install flow control devices such as low-flow shower heads and flush valves.
- Faculty and students to be instructed from time to time to use water economically.
- World water day, World Environment Day to be celebrated to spread awareness for the importance of water conservation.
- Guest lectures and expert lectures to be arranged regularly on water conservation.
- Sprinkler irrigation system shall be used for watering lawns and plants.
- Banners and/or stickers for awarenesson Water conservation to be installed at different strategic placesto educate the students and staff.
