

TEACHERS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS (2023-24)

Towards the objectives of institutional progress and students-centric curriculum delivery and enrichment, the Faculty of the College plays an active role at multiple levels. To identify gaps in the University prescribed curriculum and existing teaching-learning system, faculty strive for continuous refinement as per latest needs of the target groups of course objectives and outcomes. They facilitate and participate in a mandatory process of collecting feedback on different aspects which are essential for qualitative changes in teaching-learning in the institution. They respond to a Proforma prepared by a feedback committee in consultation with IQAC, Principal and management of the College. A feedback analysis report has been thus prepared considering the relevant and specific suggestions given by faculty pertaining to curriculum and other important aspects.

The report was received from the committee for further review and discussion. After intense and threadbare deliberations, the recommendations are made in the Action Taken Report. The feedback report to be shared with stakeholders is accordingly communicated.

TEACHERS FEEDBACK

The total 128 teachers gave feedback for the year 2023-24 illustrated that more than 90 per cent were fully acquainted with the university syllabi of theory as well as practical. Almost all the faculty members are satisfied with the curriculum delivery in the college that is conducive to teaching-learning process. Their feedback reflects that facilities like IT tools/infrastructure, library support and adequate opportunities for upgrading teaching skills are provided by the institution.

The faculty has expressed their high satisfaction with the leadership of the Principal and Management of the institution. Feedback analysis also reveals valuable suggestions such as suggestions in syllabus, examination reforms and renovation or improvement in college laboratories for better practical experience and experiential learning. Though, the overall report of teacher's feedback analysis reveals that teachers are fully satisfied with the general development and facilities provided to them. A small number of them gave their suggestions.




FEEDBACK REVIEW









The college has given me full freedom to adopt new techniques/strategies of teaching such as group discussions, seminar presentations and learners' participation


I have the freedom to adopt new techniques/ strategies of testing and assessment of students






Tests and examinations (internal & university) are conducted well in time with proper coverage of complete syllabus

The prescribed books are available in the Library in Sufficient numbers







The environment in the College is conducive to teaching-learning

The management is teacher friendly









The college provides adequate opportunities and support to faculty members for upgrading their skills and qualifications such as exposure to research, seminars, conferences, etc

ICT facilities in the college are adequate and satisfactory







Separate space in the college Canteen is available for Teachers

Toilets/ washrooms in the staffroom are clean and properly maintained









Staffroom has proper space and comfortable sitting capacity

The college has recreation facilities for the teaching staff






The college provides conducive environment for teachers to prepare for the competitive exam, aptitude tests? etc.
